Inglenook wines have a proven track record of aging gracefully for decades. With twenty-one years of age, the 1991 Rubicon reflects the pedigree of our estate and immense longevity of our flagship Bordeaux-blend. From a tasting conducted on December 18, 2012, we note that the wine has attained lasting hints from all stages of development thus creating a highly evolved bouquet that delivers notes of wilted roses, figs, plums and cherries combined with a spice complement of ginger, anise and cinnamon, tobacco, leather and a light herbaceous quality. On the palate, the wine is younger in taste than the nose suggests, offering long sweet flavors of dried cherries, a fat mouthfeel, residual tannins and a lengthy, expressive finish rich in fruit until the very end.
